When is this program offered?

This program starts in September of each year, and continues to mid-August of the following year.

Can I use these credits towards a designation?

Students interested in pursuing a professional, recognized accounting designation are advised to check with the relevant accounting body website, and to continue to check these websites on regular basis for updates.

What are the admission requirements?

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent. Applicants with an OSSD showing English, Grade 12 (ENG4C or equivalent) and Mathematics, Grade 12 (MAP4C or equivalent).

What would I learn?

This program prepares students to work in various areas of accounting including financial accounting, managerial accounting, taxation and information systems. Students are also exposed to a number of accounting and business computer software packages.

What equipment do I need?

Students are expected to have and use a laptop or mobile computing device when registered in this on-campus program. Hardware and software specifications required by your program are outlined at www.algonquincollege.com/byod.
