

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Algonquin College is offering Entrance Bursaries to students who are enrolling in the first term of their full-time post-secondary program.

Students in a Diploma program will be eligible for a \$500 bursary and students enrolled in a Degree program will be eligible for a bursary of \$1,000. Students enrolled in Certificate Programs are not eligible for the Entrance Bursary. Entrance Bursaries are based on demonstrated financial need.

Deadlines to Apply:

2009 Fall Term: September 18, 2009

2010 Winter Term: January 16, 2010

You will be notified of the Entrance Bursary decision by mail within two weeks of your application being received at the College.

As the number of Entrance Bursaries is limited, it is strongly recommended that you submit your completed Entrance Bursary Application promptly to the Financial Aid Office. Note: Incomplete Bursary applications will be denied.

Cheques will be mailed by October 13, 2009 for the Fall 2009 Term and February 5, 2010 for the Winter 2010 Term to eligible, registered full-time Algonquin College students. For students with outstanding College fees, the bursary award will be applied to their Algonquin College account.
