Position Summary

Reporting directly to the College's Academic Dean, the Chair, Foundation Program is responsible for contributing to the academic well-being and growth of Algonquin College - Kuwait (AC-Kuwait) and for providing academic and administrative leadership, supervision, support and direction to the faculty and staff in the Foundation Program. In consultation with Algonquin College - Canada, the Chair plans, organizes and manages the Foundation program and its courses and resources and ensures that they conform to both Kuwaiti and Canadian standards and requirements. The Chair also ensures that College applicants are effectively assessed, placed and advised and that Program graduates are adequately prepared to enter AC-Kuwait diploma programs.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

In consultation with the Academic Dean, the Chair, Foundation Program:

- Engages with a wide range of internal and external stakeholders including appropriate representatives of Algonquin College - to design, develop and implement the Foundation Program's strategic academic, quality assurance, performance management and enrolment management plans and strategies, including annual goals and objectives.
- Contributes to AC-Kuwait's development as an academic institution and as a branch campus of Algonquin College Ottawa by ensuring that all members of the Foundation Program team:
 - Are committed to academic excellence, continuous improvement, and quality assurance;
 - Use the latest technologies, methods and approaches to engage students and create and maintain teaching/learning environments that are positive and supportive;
 - Act in accordance and compliance with College policies, procedures and standards.
- Oversees all aspects of Foundation Program activity and performance including:
 - Developing annual business plans and budgets and monitoring, analysing and reporting performance;
 - Ensuring that resources are allocated and available in an effective, timely manner;
 - Developing, acquiring and adapting outcome/competency-based curricula and teaching and learning resources and ensuring their appropriateness to Foundation Program students' culture, learning styles and needs;
 - Designing and delivering instruction, student evaluation, and applicant assessment, placement and advisement;
 - Recruiting, hiring, orientating, training/developing, scheduling, assigning, supervising and evaluating faculty and staff;
 - Responding expeditiously to appeals and complaints from staff, faculty and students and, where appropriate, referring them to the Academic Dean;
 - Developing and implementing effective occupational health and safety programs.



- Acts as the Director, Community Engagement and Outreach's academic partner in the development, delivery and evaluation of Continuing Education and Contract Training English and Communication programs, courses and workshops.
- Demonstrably contributes to the success of the Academic Division by:
 - Actively participating as a member of the Academic Leadership Team;
 - Helping to develop, implement and monitor the Division's strategic plan and goals;
 - Cooperatively allocating and managing resources and achieving and sustaining fiscal viability;
 - Participating in a wide range of operational problem-solving and decision making activities;
 - Ensuring that the Academic Leadership team is informed about Foundation Program issues and actions which may impact divisional operations.
