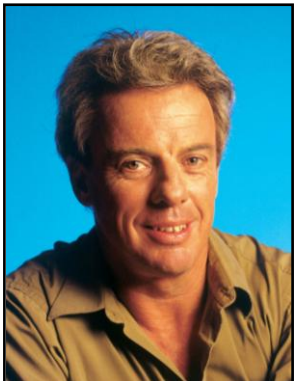

## **“Everything You Know Is Wrong”: Great Leaps in Scientific Thought**

Algonquin College's annual lecture features Bob McDonald, one of Canada's most interesting and respected science journalists, who will enlighten us about some of the world's most amazing scientific discoveries.



Bob McDonald is the host of the CBC Radio's award-winning science program, *Quirks & Quarks*, which has aired for the past 35 years. The program is heard weekly by a national audience of nearly 500,000 listeners, and by thousands more around the world on the CBC's weekly podcast.

Mr. McDonald has hosted *Quirks & Quarks* since 1992 and is a frequent science commentator on “The National” with Peter Mansbridge. He is also an author, as well as host and creator of children's science television programs. Mr. McDonald has been honoured for his contribution of bringing science awareness to Canadians, having received numerous awards from science organizations as well as honorary degrees from Canadian Universities.

His illustrated presentation in Pembroke will be in honour of the International Year of Astronomy and the International Year of Darwin.
