6 tips for supporting Autistic students in your class:

- The TSC supports students on their college journey through learning strategy support and social/peer support.
- 2. Autistic students may have challenges related to executive functioning, sensory processing, physical and/or vocal stims that they mask in order to blend into the class environment.
- 3. Share deadlines and project expectations as early as possible in the semester.
- 4. Use concrete language in student feedback and expectations. Avoid colloquialisms and sarcasm.
- 5. For online classes, default settings to camera off for students to join the group.
- 6. Autistic students may need support joining and coordinating group projects.
