### Ride for Refuge – Gear Up for a Good Cause

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There is no shortage of charitable events that you can run, walk, and cycle in to raise money.

Ride for Refuge is another one of those events that is family friendly and geared (pun intended!) to all ability levels.

Created in 2004, this event hosts bike rides across North America and raises funds for more than 175 charities that support the vulnerable, displaced, and the exploited. These charities are made up of both local and international agencies.

This year, the event was held in 23 cities within Canada, including Ottawa, on October 5. Three hundred

and twelve riders on 53 teams rode 10 km, 25 km, or 50 km through the beautiful autumn landscape bordering Carp and Kanata. The teams surpassed the donation goal and collected just over \$77,000. Across North America, the event raised \$1.6 million dollars.

The money collected through the ride helps individuals in Africa, Asia, North America, Europe, Central America and South America. The beneficiaries are agencies who support the abused, First Nations peoples, the homeless, human trafficking, refugees, and sex trade workers among others. Local agencies receiving support include Matthew House, Cornerstone Housing for Women, and the Ottawa Mission.
