

Subject Guides


The library has a collection of curated subject-specific guides, which offer an overview of related books, videos, articles, and web resources. Subject guides are available for most programs and subjects.

Crash Course


Crash Course is an educational YouTube channel that has digestible and fun videos on topics including anatomy and physiology, chemistry, and statistics
